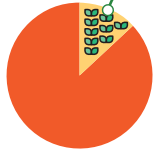

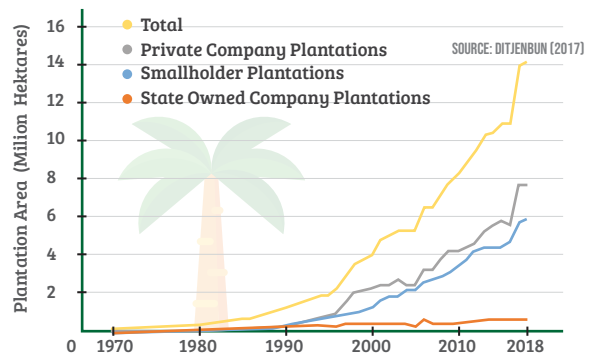

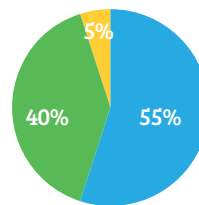

- Smallholder Plantations → **3,01 Ton/Ha**

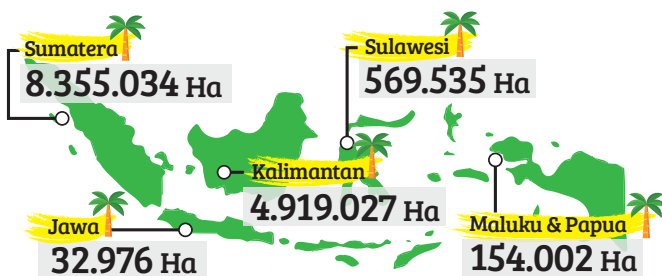

## Distribution of Oil Palm Plantations in Indonesia in 2017

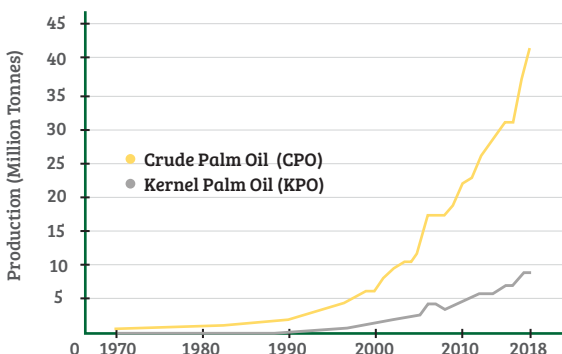

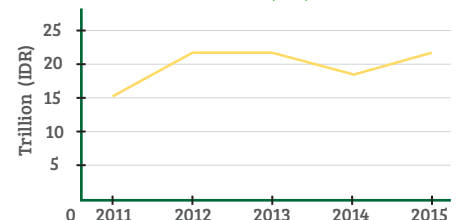
